While our volunteers and donors give us the chance to show communities who we are and what we value, there is a whole lot more healing, caring and giving going on behind the scenes.




Children are resilient, however an extra hand is sometimes needed to help them become triumphant. Bloomin' Boutique is at the ready.

Thank you for making the "Tween Station" facility a reality!

Faced with the ongoing need to serve more and more children, and with the help of community, friends and family, Bloomin' Boutique added a third facility to prepare care packages

As the requests for services continues to escalate, we have been fortunate enough that our donations have kept pace, pushing the limits on how much we can process at our two original facilities. Rather than looking for a single larger space, Bloomin' Boutique opted to look for a third space while maintaining our primary "Boutique" space that is provided at a charitable rate by the building owner and our "Annex" space that has been totally donated for a number of years.

The "new" 900 sq ft space has been completed with the help of generous donations of time and materials and is also being provided at no cost. All three facilities are located in Oregon City and will prepare care packages for different age groups. The "Boutique" prepares requests and offers shopping experiences for middle and high school kids; the "Annex" fulfills requests for kids birth through 7 years old; the new "Tween Station" space processes 8 to 12 year olds.

A sincere shout out to everyone for opening their generous hearts to see this project come to life!!!







Each of us has a story -

an unforgettable life-changing event making such an impact that we never forget the feelings we experienced.

See that girl in the pink pants? That was me the first time I got to go shopping for something new – something I got to pick out for myself. In that moment, I could see beyond all that was going wrong – the mother I had lost, the father that did not have the skills to cope with four small children, the trail of domestic violence, the fear

of foster care services looming at the door. *In that moment,* I felt confident to take on the world. *In that moment,* I was seen, I was important, I was loved.

Q: How quickly are care packages assembled? A: In general, care packages are ready for pick-up within a week of receiving the fulfillment request. When facing an emergency situation, volunteers focus on making a difference as quickly as humanly possible. Two recent examples include preparing a care package of clothes, diapers and blankets for a preemie baby delivered by a single mom and preparing clothes and other items for a family with seven children who lost all of their belongings in a house

Q: How do you identify who to serve?

A: We rely on community agencies - governmental, medical, schools - to screen for those in need and their advocates, in turn, submit fulfillment requests to us. Our Board of Directors has adopted policies regarding anti-discrimination and the number of times an individual may receive assistance, but we do not directly identify or solicit anyone.

took place on the same day as the request was made!

Q: How many children do you help each month?

A: We have attempted to set a goal of providing for 720 children each year. This is the "magic" number we feel can be comfortably sustained over the long run based on current donation levels. That number also allows our volunteer workers the ability to give each care package the special attention it needs to fulfill a child's requests. However, it is impossible to ignore the need which continues to grow, so the number of fulfilled requests varies each month. At times, our volunteers have stepped up to help 90 kids in a month... thirty percent more than our "set" goal! The retail value of a care package is estimated at \$500, so it is also critical to be cognizant of how many packages are being provided each month... and this is why continuing donations are so very important!

O: How can community organizations help?

A: Groups can help by organizing clothing drives... socks, underwear, pajamas... any NEW clothing items! We feel it is very important that we only provide NEW clothing. These kids deserve to feel special. For some, these will be the first "new" clothes they have ever received. Recently, a group of sports teams held a competition to see which team could collect the most kids underwear with the winning team getting a pizza party. The result: they collected nearly 900 pair... a 3 month supply for Bloomin' Boutique... and all teams got a pizza party to celebrate their community service!
